Below are some tips for you to have a successful Kids Helping Kids program.

- ✓ Have a Definite Start and End Date - Organizations that have scheduled a Start and End date have had the most success.
- ✓ Be Creative - Every week, you have an opportunity to remind the children about bringing in change. Find fun and exciting ways to help them remember.
- ✓ Stay Connected with Parents - It's great to keep not only the child engaged but the parents as well. Encourage parents to talk to their children at home about ZOE and how they can collect change.
- ✓ Let's Earn Change - Though children may be quick to ask family and friends to help them collect change, we highly recommend emphasizing children to think of ways to earn money. Children are so creative when put to the challenge of ways to earn money.
- ✓ Collection Bag - It may be wise to have a small bag for the children use to bring in their collected change. Maybe have them decorate their own plastic baggies to make it more personal.
